The Roads Corporation, trading as VicRoads, awards you Contract No. 9974 for supply, installation and/or replacement of continuous black profiled edge and centre lines (non-reflective), replacement of raised pavement markers and re-marking centre and edge line marking in waterborne paint on various roads in South West Victoria, Parts A, B & C in accordance with the contract document, including any post tender correspondence, on a schedule of rates basis for an estimated contract sum of \$12,348,174.19. The contract sum is based on VicRoads estimate of the quantities of work.

Two copies of the Formal Instrument of Agreement and the other documents comprising the contract will be forwarded to you shortly for execution. Under the General Conditions of Contract, you are required to return all these documents, duly executed, to VicRoads, Procurement Services, Ground Floor, 60 Denmark Street, Kew, Vic 3101 within 10 business days of receipt of the documents.

The security of \$308,704.00, being 2.5% of the contract sum, is to be lodged at Procurement Services, Ground Floor, 60 Denmark Street, Kew, Vic 3101 within 20 business days of the date of this letter. The security may be submitted in any of the approved forms referred to in sub-clause 5.3 of the General Conditions of Contract. Retention from payments shall be at 5% to a maximum of 2.5% of the contract sum.

Your attention is drawn to Clause 22 of the General Conditions of Contract relating to the inspection of insurance policies. This Contract is awarded on the basis of the Contract being included in the VicRoads Principal Arranged Public Liability Insurance Scheme. It will be necessary for you to produce to the Superintendent prior to commencing work:

- evidence that you are insured or self-insured for the purposes of the *Workplace Injury Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2013*.

The Director Safe System Road Infrastructure Program, VicRoads, 1 McNab Street, Footscray Vic 3011 is appointed Superintendent for the Contract.

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Contractor's Payment Claims are to be served upon the Superintendent as the VicRoads nominee and the Superintendent will provide Payment Schedules, in accordance with the *Building and Construction Security of Payment Act 2002*, as amended, to the Contractor.

The date of acceptance of tender is - 6 FEB 2019

The time for Practical Completion of the Works shall be fifty (50) weeks from the date of the Letter of Award.
