Group:	OTHER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES			
Category:	BRIDGE INSPECTION			
	This category of pre-qualification is required for a Company with capacity and capability to undertake bridge inspections at the VicRoads level 2.			
	All pre-qualified consultants in this category will be required to participate in regular reviews of performance in relation to the performance assessment criteria for these suppliers.			
Levels:	Bridge Condition Inspections- Level 2 (BI 2)			
	Standard Eligibility Criteria			
	<ul> <li>To be eligible a Company must demonstrate:</li> <li>Personnel experienced in the area of competency</li> <li>Relevant experience and satisfactory performance commensurate with Level 2 inspection competency</li> <li>Quality and OH&amp;S management systems that are either 3<sup>rd</sup> party certified (refer to 'Management System Guidelines'', Part B of the application document), or audited to VicRoads checklists, or as a minimum requirement, Operational Management Systems (Refer to document titled "Operational Management Systems (Refer to document titled "Operational Management Systems Requirements)</li> <li>Evidence that the company has a Victorian WorkCover insurance policy or proof of self-insurance which covers all personnel engaged in the delivery of services</li> <li>Professional indemnity Insurance – Minimum of \$2 million subject to specific contract requirements</li> </ul> Specific Eligibility Criteria* <ul> <li>Successful completion of the ARRB Level 2 Bridge Inspection course in Victoria or an equivalent approved in writing by VicRoads for this purpose</li> <li>Extensive practical experience in inspection, construction, design, maintenance or repair of bridge and road related structures</li> <li>Competency to judge the condition of structures and the importance of visual defects <ul> <li>Facility to access advice from a qualified professional bridge engineer if required**</li> <li>Attendance at a VicRoads Level 2 accreditation briefing</li> <li>Satisfactory performance in the accreditation briefing assignment</li> </ul></li></ul>			
	<ul> <li>Notes</li> <li>* Specific eligibility criteria are based on the Road Structures Inspection Manual requirements.</li> <li>** Level 2 inspectors are not required to be qualified professional bridge engineers.</li> </ul>			
	Area of Competency			
	<ul> <li>Carry out bridge condition inspections including:</li> <li>Visual inspection of bridge components to access their condition</li> <li>Reporting the condition and extent inspection of the structures components</li> <li>identifying components that limit the performance of the structure</li> <li>identifying the probable causes and factors of deterioration</li> </ul>
