	<p>This category of pre-qualification is required for a Company with capacity and capability to undertake bridge inspections at the VicRoads level 2.</p> <p>All pre-qualified consultants in this category will be required to participate in regular reviews of performance in relation to the performance assessment criteria for these suppliers.</p>
Levels:	Bridge Condition Inspections- Level 2 (BI 2)
	<p><u>Standard Eligibility Criteria</u></p> <p><i>To be eligible a Company must demonstrate:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personnel experienced in the area of competency • Relevant experience and satisfactory performance commensurate with Level 2 inspection competency • Quality and OH&S management systems that are either 3rd party certified (refer to 'Management System Guidelines', Part B of the application document), or audited to VicRoads checklists, or as a minimum requirement, Operational Management Systems (Refer to document titled "Operational Management Systems Requirements) • Evidence that the company has a Victorian WorkCover insurance policy or proof of self-insurance which covers all personnel engaged in the delivery of services • Professional indemnity Insurance – Minimum of \$2 million subject to specific contract requirements <p><u>Specific Eligibility Criteria*</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Successful completion of the ARRB Level 2 Bridge Inspection course in Victoria or an equivalent approved in writing by VicRoads for this purpose • Extensive practical experience in inspection, construction, design, maintenance or repair of bridge and road related structures • Competency to judge the condition of structures and the importance of visual defects • Facility to access advice from a qualified professional bridge engineer if required** • Attendance at a VicRoads Level 2 accreditation briefing • Satisfactory performance in the accreditation briefing assignment <p>Notes</p> <p>* Specific eligibility criteria are based on the Road Structures Inspection Manual requirements.</p> <p>** Level 2 inspectors are not required to be qualified professional bridge engineers.</p> <p>Area of Competency</p> <p>Carry out bridge condition inspections including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Visual inspection of bridge components to assess their condition ▪ Reporting the condition and extent inspection of the structures components ▪ identifying components that limit the performance of the structure ▪ identifying the probable causes and factors of deterioration
